

Information clause on personal data processing

1. Information about the Data Administrator:

2. The purposes of processing personal data and the legal basis for processing:

We process your data for the following purposes:

- 1) answering all directed inquiries or requests and conducting further correspondence or contact before concluding the contract;
- 2) archival (evidence) to secure information in the event of a legal need to prove facts, which is our legitimate interest;
- 3) storing data to ensure accountability, including demonstrating our compliance with legal obligations.

3. Information about the recipients of your personal data:

If necessary, we may provide your personal data in order to answer the question. We will pass data to the following groups:

- persons authorized by us, our employees and associates who must have access to data in order to perform their duties;
- public entities, if this results from an obligation imposed by law.

4. Period of storage of your personal data:

Your personal data will be stored by us for the period necessary to handle the inquiry. If the effect of the correspondence will be the conclusion of a contract, we will further process your personal data in order to perform the contract. If no cooperation is established, your data will be deleted by us.

5. Your rights:

In relation to the processing of personal data by us, you have the following rights: access to the content of your data and rectification, deletion or limitation of processing;

- data transfer;
- requests to delete personal data, except when their processing is necessary to comply with the legal obligation incumbent on the Administrator;
- object to the processing of personal data for purposes arising from our legitimate interests;
- file a complaint to the President of the Office for Data Protection when the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the General Regulation on the Protection of Personal Data of April 27th, 2016.

6. Providing your personal data is voluntary, however, it is necessary for us to answer the question.
